Woman's Open	- Madison system - Average weight plus or minus 10%	

Mens University Open - Age as of June 27th 1973 to 1993

Mens Senior Open - Age as of June 27th before 1973

Mens & Woman's Open will be Madison system unless the bracket has 6 or more then the bracket will be a modified double elimination bracket.

Tournament Format for the "Youth & Open"

Madison system, Round Robin or Double elimination random draw depending on number of participants.

Medals awarded to the 1st through 3rd place finishers.

Scoring

1- point awarded for gaining a normal takedown.
2- points awarded for a takedown in which the defensive wrestler is taken directly to his or her back and held for a 1 to 4 count.

3- points awarded for a takedown in which the defensive wrestler is taken directly to his or her back and held for at least a five count.

When the referee see's that the wrestlers back fits the "fall criteria", pinned within the 5 count, the match ends even if time remains.

Peewee & Bantam - one 2 minute period

All other divisions - one 3 minute period

Wrestlers will be brought to neutral position after points scored, stalemate and stalling. Stalling penalties will be 1st caution, 2nd 1 point 3rd disqualification.

If at any time during the match a wrestler leads by 10 points, it is considered a technical fall and the match is over.

In the event of a tie at the end of the period, a one (1) minute sudden death period will start in the neutral position. If the tie remains the wrestler who scored last is the winner. In the event of a 0-0 tie, there will be a 1 minute sudden death round starting in neutral position. Still no score a coin will be tossed for choice in the referee's position, this will be 30 second rounds until a score has been established.

In all Youth brackets HEAD GEAR must be worn.
It is suggested that all wrestlers wear head gear.

Concessions will be available all day.
